1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class. No arrangements accepted over 24" in diameter or 4' in height unless otherwise stated.
2. Only one person to work on arrangement.
3. An arranger MUST stay in division - they can neither go in a division higher nor lower.
4. All arrangements must contain some fresh material, unless otherwise stated.
5. Fresh cut plant material means: flowers, foliage, branches, fruits, vegetables, succulents. Exhibitor's choice of material means: Any kind of fresh and/or dried plant or spray-painted or treated plant material. No dyed fresh flowers or imitation or artificial plant material permitted.
6. NO POISON OAK!

DIVISION 371-AMATEUR ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won not more than ten blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class	Notes:
1. "Persian Pleasure Garden"	Use fragrant plant material.
2. "Our Anderson Valley World"	Use grapes and apples in arrangement.
3. "Going Dutch"	Use a wooden shoe.
4. "Queen Elizabeth's Rose Dream"	Use only roses for flowers.
5. "African Beat"	Use drum in arrangement.

FLORICULTURE-ARRANGEMENTS

DIVISION 372-INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won at least 11 but not more than 20 blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class	Notes:
1. "Brazilian Carnival"	Use tropical type flowers, include a mask.
2. "Chinese Gift"	Use bamboo to enhance delicate flowers.
3. "Spice Island"	Use multiple spice containers. Arrangement must have an aspect.
4. "World Peace"	Use olive branches and flowers of every color of the rainbow.
5. "All Itallinate"	Formal arrangement, using only green.

DIVISION 373-ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won twenty or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class	Notes:
1. "French Champagne"	Include a champagne bottle, glass and bubbles.
2. "North and South Korea"	2 arrangements with main color of one as accent color in second and visa versa.
3. "Japanese Ikebana"	Arrangement must be ikebana style and use a florist frog.
4. "English Country Garden"	Arrangement in three tiers.
5. "Earth from Space"	Create globe shaped arrangement, using blue and greens.

DIVISION 374-SPECIAL CATEGORY

1. Not open to Commercial exhibitors.
2. One person only to work on arrangement.
3. One entry per exhibitor per class.
4. No arrangement accepted over 24" in diameter or 4' in height.
5. Roses used in this arrangement must have been introduced or known to be grown before 1900.
6. SPECIAL NOTE: A display card must accompany the arrangement indicating the names and dates of introduction of the roses used in the arrangement (card not to be judged).

1. Heritage Rose Arrangement
