2. Each entry in these divisions shall have been made or produced by the exhibitor. Entries shall be made on Junior Department entry forms provided by the Fair. *The signature of a parent or guardian is required.*
3. State and Local Rules apply to all entries.
4. Exhibitors who are enrolled in any junior organization for which classes are offered elsewhere are not eligible to enter in these divisions.
5. The exhibitor within the county, district or community represented by the exhibitor must have grown exhibits in the Floriculture Department.

**DIVISION 990—GARDENS - INDOOR OR OUTDOOR PLANTERS**

*All plants must be rooted*  
*Limit two (2) entries per class.*

Class

1. House Plants
2. Succulent garden, not to exceed 12"

Class

3. Dish garden or nature planter, not to exceed 12"

**ARRANGEMENTS**

1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class.
2. Arrangements must not be arranged in soil.

**DIVISION 991—NOVICE ARRANGEMENTS**

*Open to junior exhibitors who have won not more than three (3) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class

1. “Bandera Mexicana”
2. “Made in USA”

Notes:

Use only colors of Mexican Flag.  
Use only red, white, and blue flowers.

**DIVISION 992—INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS**

*Open to junior exhibitors who have won three (3) blue ribbons but not more than ten (10) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class

1. “Canadian Pride”
2. “Bells of Ireland”

Notes:

Use maple leaves with red and white flowers.  
Use bell shaped flowers in green container.

**DIVISION 993—ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS**

*Open to junior exhibitors who have won 10 or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class

1. “Deep in the Jungle”
2. “A trip to Antarctica”

Notes:

Use lush plant material surrounding a “hidden” element.  
Use all white flowers in a boat shaped container.
