1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class. No arrangements accepted over 24" in diameter or 4' in height unless otherwise stated.
2. Only one person to work on arrangement.
3. An arranger MUST stay in division - they can neither go in a division higher nor lower.
4. All arrangements must contain some fresh material, unless otherwise stated.
5. Fresh cut plant material means: flowers, foliage, branches, fruits, vegetables, succulents. Exhibitor's choice of material means: Any kind of fresh and/or dried plant or spray-painted or treated plant material. No dyed fresh flowers or imitation or artificial plant material permitted.
6. NO POISON OAK!

**DIVISION 92-AMATEUR ARRANGEMENTS**

*Open to exhibitors who have won not more than ten blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class	Notes:
1. "Her Carriage Turned Back Into A Pumpkin"	Use a pumpkin as a container.
2. "Little Red Riding Hood"	Use all red flowers and woodland foliage.
3. "Frog Prince"	Use a florist's 'frog.' Make 1 flower stand out.
4. "Pied Piper"	Include a wind instrument in arrangement.
5. "Mirror Mirror"	Use a mirror in arrangement.

## FLORICULTURE-ARRANGEMENTS

### DIVISION 93-INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS

*Open to exhibitors who have won at least 11 but not more than 20 blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class	Notes:
1. "The Elves and the Shoe Maker"	Use shoe as container. Use all small or mini flowers.
2. "Cinderella"	Use high heeled shoe for container.
3. "Snow White"	Use all white flowers. Arrangement must be short and long.
4. "Puss in Boots"	Use a boot for container. Include pussy willows.
5. "Sleeping Beauty"	Use a low container, covered with moss.

### DIVISION 94-ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS

*Open to exhibitors who have won twenty or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.*

Class	Notes:
1. "Goldilocks and the Three Bears"	Three arrangements: small, medium, and large. Use mostly yellow or gold flowers.
2. "The Princess and the Pea"	3-5 layer design in a clear container. Fill the container with peas.
3. "Beauty and the Beast"	Two arrangements of opposite design and color.
4. "Mirror Mirror"	Twin Arrangements.
5. "7 Dwarves"	7 small arrangements, all different, but with some aspect that repeats through them all.

### DIVISION 95-SPECIAL CATEGORY

1. Not open to Commercial exhibitors.
2. One person only to work on arrangement.
3. One entry per exhibitor per class.
4. No arrangement accepted over 24" in diameter or 4' in height.
5. Roses used in this arrangement must have been introduced or known to be grown before 1900.
6. SPECIAL NOTE: A display card must accompany the arrangement indicating the names and dates of introduction of the roses used in the arrangement (card not to be judged).
