2. Each entry in these divisions shall have been made or produced by the exhibitor. Entries shall be made on Junior Department entry forms provided by the Fair. *The signature of a parent or guardian is required.*
3. State and Local Rules apply to all entries.
4. Exhibitors who are enrolled in any junior organization for which classes are offered elsewhere are not eligible to enter in these divisions.
5. The exhibitor within the county, district or community represented by the exhibitor must have grown exhibits in the Floriculture Department.

DIVISION 332—GARDENS - INDOOR OR OUTDOOR PLANTERS

All plants must be rooted
Limit two (2) entries per class.

Class

1. House Plants
2. Succulent garden, not to exceed 12"

Class

3. Dish garden or nature planter, not to exceed 12"

ARRANGEMENTS

1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class.
2. Arrangements must not be arranged in soil.

DIVISION 333—NOVICE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won not more than three (3) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. "Hansel and Grettel"
2. "Ugly Duckling"

Notes:

Include candy in arrangement.
Use white feathers in arrangement.

DIVISION 334—INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won three (3) blue ribbons but not more than ten (10) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. "Emperor's New Clothes"
2. "Puss in Boots"

Notes:

Float a flowerhead in a clear glass container.
Use Boot as container. Include pussy willows.

DIVISION 335—ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won 10 or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. "Rapunzel"
2. "Wicked Witch"

Notes:

Use long wispy flowers and foliage in a tall cylindrical container.
Use and apple and dark colored flowers in the arrangement.
