DIVISION 990—GARDENS - INDOOR OR OUTDOOR PLANTERS

All plants must be rooted
Limit two (2) entries per class.

1. House Plants
2. Succulent garden not to exceed 12"
3. Dish garden or nature planter not to exceed 12"
4. Little Red Wagon Use any color, vintage or new wagon. Plants may be left in individual containers as long as containers are not visible, or may be planted directly in soil in wagon. Any and all plant material is acceptable. Fill to at least 75% with plants.

ARRANGEMENTS

1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class.
2. Arrangements must not be arranged in soil.

DIVISION 991–NOVICE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won not more than three (3) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. “Win Your Sweetheart a Prize”
2. “Merry-Go-Round”

Notes:

include a stuffed animal in your design.
Create an arrangement in round with various colored flowers.

DIVISION 992–INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won three (3) blue ribbons but not more than ten (10) blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. “Gold Fish Friends”
2. “Sheep Dog Sweet Hearts”

Notes:

Use a majority of gold and yellow flowers in a gold fish bowl.
Include 2 red roses in a one-sided arrangement.
The rest of the flowers should be small.

DIVISION 993–ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS

Open to junior exhibitors who have won 10 or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class

1. “Picture’ Perfect Fair”
2. “4-H Friends”

Notes:

Include your own photo/painting/drawing in your design.
Include multiple Fair Animals in your design.
