

## FINE ARTS

1. Work submitted must have been completed since the conclusion of the last Mendocino County Fair and Apple Show, Sunday, September 16, 2018.
2. Paintings and photographs must be COMPLETELY ORIGINAL - that is, they must not have been copied in whole or in part from any previously existing picture or photographs. The sole exception would be the use of a photograph made by the exhibiting artist himself.
3. Kit products and/or projects are not acceptable.
4. State and Local Rules and Regulations heretofore contained governing exhibitors and exhibits will also govern all exhibitors and exhibits in this department.
5. The management shall reserve the right to vacate, as ineligible for competition, any entry, which is not in the best interest of the Fair or is deemed inappropriate for family viewing.
6. All pictures must be ADEQUATELY FRAMED AND READY FOR HANGING (screw eye attached), not more than 48 inches in length or width. Without fair approval, only THOROUGHLY DRY oil paintings will be accepted.
7. Consult the appropriate division for when ENTRY FORMS AND EXHIBITS ARE DUE. No entries will be accepted by the Fair Office.
8. Exhibits will be accepted at the Home Arts/Fine Arts Building, Wednesday, September 4 through Thursday, September 5, 9:00 a.m. – 6:30 p.m. NO EXHIBITS WILL BE ACCEPTED BEFORE OR AFTER THESE DATES. Exhibits will be judged Saturday, September 7.
9. There is no limit to the number of items you may enter in a class, however, in accordance with state regulations, you may only receive TWO cash awards in any class. See state rule IV-6.
10. Honorable Mentions awarded at the discretion of the Judges.
11. The judge will award first, second, or third place, etc. according to merit; if without merit, the judge will make no award under any circumstances. This rule applies whether there are one or more entries in the class.
12. The BEST OF SHOW award winner is INELIGIBLE to compete for Best of Show two years in succession.
