### THEME: "MENDOCINO COUNTY ROCKS"

1. LIMIT: One entry per exhibitor per class. No arrangements accepted over 24" in diameter or 4' in height unless otherwise stated.
2. Only one person to work on arrangement.
3. An arranger MUST stay in division - they can neither go in a division higher nor lower.
4. All arrangements must contain some fresh material, unless otherwise stated.
5. Fresh cut plant material means: flowers, foliage, branches, fruits, vegetables, succulents. Exhibitor's choice of material means: Any kind of fresh and/or dried plant or spray-painted or treated plant material. No dyed fresh flowers or imitation or artificial plant material permitted.
6. NO POISON OAK!

#### DIVISION 371-AMATEUR ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won not more than ten blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

##### Class

1. "Rock'in-Country Boots"
2. "Rock N'Roll"
3. "Rock- A Bye-Baby"
4. "Rock Moss"
5. "Rock - Solid"

##### Notes:

Brightly colored flowers using a country boot as the container.  
Designers choice.  
Pastels & dainty mass floral arrangement.  
All green wilderness design including compliment wood & rock.  
An arrangement with a strong grounded focal-point, including an inspirational quote on rock of choice (quote may be painted on)

## FLORICULTURE–ARRANGEMENTS

### DIVISION 372–INTERMEDIATE ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won at least 11 but not more than 20 blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class	Notes:
1. “River Rock”	A long horizontal design representing our county’s rivers water to be visible/ exposed.
2. “Rock-Around-the-Clock”	Include a clock of choice in design.
3. “Cider on the Rocks”	Use clear vase container filled with fresh or fake apples topped with harmonious flowers, spices, and apples.
4. “Mendocino Rock-Star”	A tall vertical design – include any form of a Star(s) shape.
5. “Rock-Solid”	An arrangement with a strong grounded focal-point, including an inspirational quote on a rock of choice. (quote may be painted on)

### DIVISION 373–ADVANCED ARRANGEMENTS

Open to exhibitors who have won twenty or more blue ribbons at an organized flower show.

Class	Notes:
1. “Rock-out”	Create an elevated, expansive design from center-outward.
2. “Rock - Hound”	Designer choice.
3. “Between A Rock & Hard Place”	Create an industrious, compositional arrangement including one single flower.
4. “Rocking Horse”	A western design using any horse / or horse related object.
5. “Rock - Solid”	An arrangement with a strong grounded focal point, including an inspirational quote on rock of choice (quote may be painted on).

### DIVISION 374–SPECIAL CATEGORY

1. Not open to Commercial exhibitors.
2. One person only to work on arrangement.
3. One entry per exhibitor per class.
4. No arrangement accepted over 24” in diameter or 4’ in height.
5. SPECIAL NOTE: A display card must accompany the arrangement listing varieties used in arrangement (card not to be judged).

Class	Notes:
1. “Rock of Ages - Roses”	Roses used in this arrangement are a combined use of heritage to today’s hybrids.
2. “Mendocino County Gems”	Create a Terrarium – Style arrangement under a clear container (designer’s interpretation).
3. “Living Rock”	Real rock planter containing live flowers/ plant material.
4. “Special Occasion Wreath”	Using fresh flowers & plant material. (Must include sturdy hanger)
