1. Limited to members of chapters or clubs residing in Humboldt, Lake, Mendocino and Sonoma Counties.
2. Pen space is limited. All pens assigned in order of entries received, with preference given to Mendocino County members.
3. This show will be governed by the latest rules of the ARBA (American Rabbit Breeders Assn.) and filing any entry implies acceptance of these rules. You do not have to be an ARBA member to show.
4. Official ARBA Youth Sanctioned Show sponsored by Harebrained Happening Rabbit Club. Open to all youth through 18 but limited to areas set forth in this Exhibitor Handbook. A.R.B.A. membership dues are as follows: Adult membership annual \$20 (3 years at \$50), Youth (18 and under) annual \$12 (3 years at \$30), Husband & Wife annual \$30 (3 years at \$75), Husband & Wife Family Membership annual \$30 plus \$5/youth (3 years at \$75 plus \$10/youth), Single Adult Family Membership annual \$20 plus \$5/youth (3 years at \$50 plus \$10/youth).

5. Rules, definitions and judging procedures as prescribed in the latest edition of the guide book and standard of the American Rabbit Breeder's Association, Inc. shall apply to all district and county fair rabbit shows, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Department of Food and Agriculture.
6. Rabbits will be checked for mites and fleas or signs of infection upon entering the fairgrounds. Any infected animal must be removed immediately from fairgrounds.
7. All ear numbers must be legible or the rabbit will be eliminated from competition.
8. Animals must be identified by permanent ear markings conforming to the entry form on arrival at the show. Any duplication of ear markings by an exhibitor must be eliminated and the change recorded on the judging sheet before judging.
9. Animals will be shown and judged in the proper division and class for breed, variety, age and sex only. Rabbits that are disqualified because of permanent defects, deformities, or blemishes, and those absent at the time of judging, do not count when computing the number of exhibitors in the same class.
10. A judge may Disqualify a rabbit from competition because of a temporary or curable defect but the rabbit should be counted as an entry.
11. The age in months (3 months, etc.) must be entered on the entry form for each animal entered in breed divisions. (No animal under 3 months of age.)
12. SPECIAL NOTE: Each exhibitor will be responsible for his/her animal(s) and will see that it is presented to the judge for judging and returned to its cage. Also, the exhibitor is responsible for checking the water availability in the cage throughout the duration of the fair. Exhibitor must carry his or her owns rabbit(s), or notify the clerk if there is a conflict.
13. All exhibitors will be required to wear the official show uniform of the organization they represent.
14. NO CLASS will be re-judged due to missing animals.
15. First bedding only will be supplied. Exhibitor is responsible for any bedding changes.
16. Ribbons must be picked up at the Fair Office. Ribbons will not be mailed.
17. Questions concerning entry forms will be made by telephone to the Fair office.
18. Juniors: please be aware of State Rule VIII 13 and 14 when considering entering the Open Rabbit Show.
19. **Must state on entry form if rabbit is housed at Fair or if you are going to carry on.**
20. Carry on rabbits are to be brought in through back parking lot gate.

DIVISION 897–Rabbit Meat Pen and Single Fryer

1. Meat Pen A meat pen consists of 3 rabbits of the same breed and color. They should be between 50 and 70 days old. They should weigh no less than 3lbs but no more than 5lbs.
2. Single Fryer A single fryer is one rabbit between the age of 50 and 70 days. It should weigh no less than 3lbs but no more than 5lbs. A single fryer MAY NOT be a rabbit out of a meat pen.
