### **Show Rules**

1. This show is held in strict accordance with the latest and revised Official Show Rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc.
2. All rabbits must be permanently marked in the left ear prior to showing. An ARBA licensed registrar will be available for ear marks as well as ARBA registrations.
3. Exhibitors are responsible to make sure their rabbits are taken to the judging area when called. Absolutely no refund of entry fees will be made.
4. Awards must be picked up the day of the show. Legs are sent to exhibitors within 30 days of the show.
5. All animals must be healthy and in proper sized transport cages to ensure the animals' well-being.
6. Parents - children must be under the supervision of an adult at all times.
7. The club and/or its officers are not liable for any injury or damage in connection with the show.
8. Exhibitors must clean their area upon leaving, otherwise a fine may be imposed.
9. Youth may not enter the same animal in open and youth, but they may enter different animals in open and youth. Must be entered in the Junior show to show in the Open.
10. Any issue arising that cannot be resolved by reference to the above rules shall be decided by the official show committee, whose decision shall be final.
11. Once an entry is made, the entry fee is due! Even if you are unable to attend, the fund need to be paid.

### **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS!**

1. Moving an animal to another class without secretary approval will result in disqualification of the animal.
2. Ear number changes are the only allowed changes in the showroom.
3. Confirmations are sent within 24 hours of the email entry deadline.
4. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO CHECK YOUR CONFIRMATION FOR ERRORS!
5. Final changes or corrections must be made by 6:00pm Wednesday Sept 20, 2023.
6. Include with your entry: Exhibitor name, address, city, state, zip code, phone number, and email address. Ear number, breed, class, and sex of each animal entered.
